ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival at Doha Hamad International Airport. Pick up from the airport and transfer to the hotel.

Day 2: Private Doha City Tour



- ☰ Souq Waqif is one of the top tourist attractions within Doha: traditional garments, spices, handicrafts, and souvenirs. It is also home to restaurants and Shisha lounges. The original building dates back at least from the 20th Century in a traditional Qatari architectural style.
- ☰ The Pearl-Qatar, is an artificial island spanning nearly 4km².
- ☰ The National Museum of Qatar is dedicated to bringing to life the story of Qatar and its people. The building was designed by architect Jean Nouvel who was inspired by the desert rose crystal, found in Qatar.

Day 03 - Private Desert Adventure



- ☰ Must-visit the inland sea, a dune bashing experience on 4x4 vehicle; camel ride. Explore the vast terrains; stop at the Sealine Beach. Visit the Inland Sea famous for its breathtaking beaches and sand dunes.



- ☰ INLAND SEA is one surreal place. The turquoise blue water blend with the fascinating golden hue sand. You may plan a day and indulge yourself in various activities

Day 04 - Private Qatar Heritage Tour

- ☰ Enjoy a tour of Shahaniya famous for Camel racing tracks. Discover the unique personal collections at Sheikh Faisal Museum; we end the tour with Al Shaqab Royal Horse stable, an enduring tribute to Arabian horses & tradition of equestrian excellence.

- 8) Grand Mosque
- 9) Church of our Lady of The Rosary
- 10) Souq Waqif
- 11) Aspire Park

- 13) Tornado Tower

- 16) Katara Cultural Village (waterfront, great place to stroll, with cafes, restaurants)
- 17) Katara Beach
- 18) Dune Bashing (trained driver takes you out in the sand dunes for a thrilling ride)
- 19) Khor Al Adaid (actually an inlet of the Persian Gulf, albeit just an hour from Doha),
- 20) Banana Island (operated by Thailand-based Anantara, the resort can be reached via catamaran setting off from Dhow Harbour (just by the spectacular Museum of Islamic Arts) or by private yacht. If you belong in the first category, you'll be greeted with warm smiles as you board the luxury ferry where you'll be offered Arabian coffee, dates and water. Some 20 minutes later, the sound of beating drums will welcome you onto the 13-acre island -- and usher you into a world of total relaxation. Big on comfort and lavishness, the resort strikes a great, Maldives-like first impression -- think golden sands, palm-thatched roofs and opulent rooms overlooking turquoise waters.
