Córdoba's Guadalquivir river, cereal plains, grapevines, olive trees; the mountainous Subbética range, limestone soils, feature **white villages and noble towns** with well-conserved Baroque architecture..

Seville is a mosaic of cultures: Guadalquivir river basin, Sierra Morena mountains, marshes of the Doñana Nature Reserve, lush Mediterranean vegetation, fighting bulls, extensive wetlands, birdlife sanctuary, monumental cities ...which are living testimony to a historic past of unparalleled splendor. Its art and folklore make this an exceptional tourist destination.

Granada is music and poetry, monuments which are pure art, and ancient culture. Granada's craggy summits of the Sierra Nevada mountains, breathtaking architecture, white villages scattered across hills and valleys ...is a great historic and cultural value - a tourist destination par excellence.

Valencia city is known for its historical and cultural sites, such as the cathedral which is home to the Holy Grail, the Central Market, a famous market for fresh produce and seafood, and the City of Arts and Sciences, a complex of futuristic buildings that houses a planetarium, an opera house, and a science museum

ITINERARY

1° Day (Sat.) MADRID

Meet & greet at the airport and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Accommodation at the hotel.

2° Day (Sun.) MADRID

Breakfast at the hotel. Discover the beauties of the city in a panoramic tour. Find the medieval origins of the city, like the Arabic fortress, at the Barrio de la Morería, famous for its historical buildings. Drive through the Hapsburgs District, Puerta del Sol, Plaza Mayor and Plaza de la Villa; the Madrid of the Bourbons and the complex town planning schemes of Charles III, the Royal Palace, Cibeles and Neptuno Fountains and the Puerta de Alcalá. The contemporary Madrid with areas such as Gran Vía, Castellana, the district of Salamanca, Plaza Castilla and Parque del Oeste, as well as commercial and financial areas of Modern Madrid, the emblematic Las Ventas Bullring and the Santiago Bernabéu Football Stadium. Afternoon at leisure to continue exploring the wonders that the city has to offer. Accommodation at the hotel. (B)

3° Day (Mon.) MADRID - CORDOBA - SEVILLE

Breakfast at the hotel. Bond to Andalusia, drive along La Mancha, Don Quixote's land. Brief stop at typical site in Puerto Lapice. We will drive through the natural border of Despeñaperros to reach beautiful Andalusia, a landmark of enormous heritage from a splendorous past. Arrive in Cordoba and enjoy a tour of its impressive Mosque and its narrow streets of the Jewish Quarter. Continue to Seville, a 2-hour drive. Accommodation at the hotel. (B)

4° Day (Tue.) SEVILLE

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning panoramic city tour of the Andalusian Capital, Seville. Visit the Cathedral, the second largest in the Catholic world after St. Peters in Rome. Continue to Santa Cruz quarter, the natural scenario of Carmen as well as the myth of Don Juan; Continue to Maria Luisa Park and Plaza de España. Afternoon time at leisure to enjoy the city of light. Accommodation at the hotel. (B).

5° Day (Wed.) SEVILLE - GRANADA

After breakfast at the hotel, drive east through the Caliphate road to the heart of Andalusia. We will drive across endless olive trees fields on the way to Granada - last stronghold of the Moorish Kingdoms up to 1492. Visit the world famous Alhambra complex (entrance included) and Generalife Gardens that have inspired several authors with its sound and sights, such as the "Tales of the Alhambra" by W. Irving. Accommodation at the hotel. (BD)

6° Day (Thu.) GRANADA - VALENCIA

Bond for the Mediterranean Coast after breakfast. Via Murcia and Alicante, we will reach Valencia, one of the main capitals of the Mediterranean coast with its modern Arts and Sciences Architectural Complex integrated by six elements: Hemispheric, Umbracle, Science Museum, Oceanographic, Palau de les Arts and Ágora. Valencia is also the home of the internationally well renowned and delicious Paella. Accommodation at the hotel. (B)

7° Day (Fri.) VALENCIA - BARCELONA

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning city tour of this bright city including the old town and the exterior of the most avant-garde complex: Ciudad de las Artes y las Ciencias - to contemplate the emblematic exteriors of the six buildings. Continue your journey early afternoon departure northward all along the Mediterranean coast to Catalunya, via Tarragona, the Roman Tarraco. Reach Barcelona, main Mediterranean Spanish city and home to world famous architect Gaudí, symbol of the Catalonian modernism. Accommodation at the hotel. (B)

8° Day (Sat.) BARCELONA

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning city tour of Barcelona. Drive along the main avenues with its impressive Gaudi modernist buildings such as La Pedrera and Casa Milá. The Montjuïc Park with spectacular views of the city and harbor, Olympic Ring, monument to Columbus and the Olympic Port. In the afternoon, time at leisure to visit the important landmark in the city of Barcelona, Sagrada Familia; and admire Gaudi's master work by the hand of your expert local guide. Keep on discovering this city. Accommodation at the hotel. (B)

9° Day (Sun.) BARCELONA
