Italy a living museum and UNESCO World Heritages Sites are abundant here. "Rome is the result of 3000 years of ad hoc urban development, Rome's cityscape is an exhilarating sight. Ancient icons such as the Colosseum, Roman Forum and Pantheon recall the city's golden age as caput mundi (capital of the world), while monumental basilicas tell of its history as seat of the Catholic Church. Lording it over the skyline, St Peter's Basilica towers over the Vatican, testifying to the ambition of Rome's Renaissance popes and the genius of its game-changing architects. Elsewhere, ornate piazzas and showy fountains add a baroque flourish to the city's captivating streets".

Florence and the ancient Signoria dei Medici is the preeminent cradle of culture and art; Duomo, Giotto's Bell Tower; Santa Maria Novella; Palazzo Vecchio, and the Uffizi Gallery, Arno River and Ponte Vecchio... Discover San Gimignano rolling hills covered with rows of grapevines, terra cotta roofs, and fortified towers ... Siena was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site...famous for its cuisine, art, museums, medieval cityscape and the Palio...

Chianti offers a unique landscape, with green, gentle hills covered with wide fields of vineyards and olive groves, small stone villages, characteristic parishes and countryside homes in stone.

Venice, the capital of northern Italy's Veneto region, is built on more than 100 small islands. Romantic canals, gondola rides, bridges, and 17th-century palazzi overlooking the water are simply Artistic masterpieces. "Venice and its Lagoon" site was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1987. Admire the Grand Canal lined with Renaissance and Gothic palaces; Piazza San Marco, St. Mark's Basilica; Campanile bell tower; Doge's Palace; Galleria dell'Accademia; Rialto foot bridge.

ITINERARY



DAY 1: ROME

Rome Welcome to Rome! Meet the driver and transfer to the hotel.

- 07:45PM, pick-up from hotel and to Via del Teatro Marcello. Our local expert guide will lead you to discover the wonders of the Eternal City, charming by day absolutely romantic at sunset. You will cross the characteristic area of the Jewish Ghetto, one of Rome's most beautiful neighborhoods, full with history and with a real Roman atmosphere.
- As you know, one of Rome's typical landmarks are its beautiful fountains, and one of the prettiest is the *Turtle Fountain (Fontana delle Tartarughe)* in *Piazza Mattei*. The Jewish Ghetto of Rome is the second most ancient after the one in Venice and it can be considered the heart and soul of Roman cuisine!
- Then walk into Piazza Della Rotonda and enjoy the lit view of the Pantheon, the former temple of Marcus Agrippa later converted into a church: this is the only ancient Roman temple that remained untouched through the centuries and it's stunning at night when the crowds are away.
- Next Stop...Close your eyes and throw a coin over your right shoulder straight into the Trevi Fountain: it's said that those who do so, are granted to come back to Rome someday. Your walk continues towards Piazza di Spagna, one of the city's most popular squares, known for its setting at the bottom of the Spanish Steps. Walk up these famous steps to enjoy a lovely view from the top!
- After this intense and gratifying walk, there is only one thing missing to end this experience: relax enjoying a creamy and tasty Gelato, it's on us! The tour ends in Spanish Steps area. Enjoy on your own the rest of the night. Return to the hotel on your own and overnight stay.

DAY 2 | B, D ROME · ASSISI · SIENA · FLORENCE



- 07:45M, pick-up from hotel by a deluxe coach. Arrive in Assisi, ready to explore, at your own leisure, this tiny town surrounded by walls, built in the Middle Ages. Take your time to visit the Basilica of St. Francis, where you will see masterpieces by Giotto and Cimabue and, then, have free time for lunch (not included).
- Board on the bus to reach Siena, an UNESCO World Heritage Site, world-known for the Palio (the historical horse race around the shell-shaped town square, Piazza del Campo.
- Journey to Florence, where you will check in at your hotel before enjoying dinner and a well- earned night of rest.



DAY 3 | B, L - FLORENCE



- Breakfast, wander around beautiful Florence, the "Cradle of Renaissance", when Michelangelo's art reached its pinnacle. Based on Etruscan-Roman origins, the city flourished in the Middle Ages as a free "Comune" and was further refined during the Renaissance.
- You will be fascinated by the uncountable monuments, churches and buildings as Santa Maria del Fiore, more commonly referred to as the Duomo. Contemplate its magnificent dome built by Filippo Brunelleschi.
- Cross a small piazza to see the "Campanile" tower (partly designed by Giotto) and the Baptistery, with its bronze doors where Michelangelo imagined the "Gates of Paradise." In the heart of the city, you will see Piazza della Signoria, Palazzo della Signoria (also known as Palazzo Vecchio), and the Basilica of Santa Croce.
- Lunch in a typical Tuscan restaurant in Piazza Santa Croce. Free afternoon at leisure. You can stroll Florence cobblestone streets.
- Optional: Take a short trip to Pisa, one of the four main historical Marine Republics of Italy. There, you will tour the Piazza dei Miracoli with the Duomo, Pisa's symbol "the Leaning Tower" and the Baptistery.

Dinner at leisure, overnight stay in Florence.

DAY 4 | B, D FLORENCE · BOLOGNA · PADUA · VENICE



- Breakfast in Florence, then departure to Bologna. Discover the elegant city center with its "porticos", it's shopping streets....
- From Piazza Malpighi you will walk towards the heart of the city, to Piazza del Nettuno and Piazza Maggiore (Neptune square and Major square). Continue along King Renzo's Palace; Palazzo Podestà and the Basilica of San Petronio, one of the biggest in the world. Bologna it's a real gourmet's heaven...don't miss a tasty meal at your own leisure!
- In the afternoon, head to Padova, with **Sant'Antonio Basilica**: one of the most visited churches by pilgrims of the catholic world. Later in the afternoon, arrival in Venice (Mestre). Check in at your hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

- Breakfast then transfer to Piazza San Marco. Visit the most iconic places of the "Floating City": Palazzo dei Dogi, symbol of Venice's glorious past, the legendary "Bridge of Sighs".
- After this walking tour, let us offer you a spritz or a prosecco with the company of your tour leader.
- Spend the afternoon roaming along Venice's canals at your leisure and then return to the hotel and overnight.

DAY 6 | B, L VENICE. TUSCANY WINE REGION (MONTEPULCIANO). ROME



- Breakfast, then departure from Piazzale Roma to Tuscany, world-known for its landscapes, churches and castles and its delicious wines. Proceed to Val di Chiana with a stop in Montepulciano, a medieval town rich in history and art. Known for its "Nobile" wine, on purchase in local wine houses, Montepulciano also hosts an annual Jazz and Wine Festival every July.
- Lunch in a typical restaurant included!!! After lunch, quick stop to spend some free time. In the evening, you will arrive in Rome to check in into your hotel.

DAY 7 | B ROME





- Between 7:45AM 8:00AM, after breakfast, departure from the hotel for the included tour of the Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Square with our exclusive "Skip the Line" access!
- No stress to reach the area: upon arrival, your guide will lead you into the museums where you'll visit one of the most important art collections of the world. Walk along the beautiful *Galleries of Tapestries* and Geographical Maps before admiring *Raphael's Rooms* and, then, the amazing *Sistine Chapel*. After this incredible masterpiece, the tour ends in *St. Peter's Square* where you can admire the incredible masterpiece *St. Peter's Basilica*: the biggest church in the world!
