The historic centre of Porto and the River Douro on the Gaia side, where the Port Wine lodges are located, are classified as World Heritage. Whatever it is, it certainly has to do with its people, known to be generous and easy-going, as well as the River Douro and its heritage on both banks, with its bridges and monuments, the tiles, the flowering balconies and the shopping streets.

Day 1. LISBON

Arrival at the airport or station and transportation to hotel. Free day. Hotel accommodation.

Day 2. LISBON

After breakfast, we go on a morning panoramic view of the city to admire the main plazas and avenues, **Belem Tower**, **Jerónimos Monastir**, **Discovers Monument**, **Marqués of Pombal Plaza**, and **Liberty Avenue**. Free afternoon free to enjoy the nostalgic spots of the **Alfama quarter**, **old town** next to its castle, and the charming buildings in the narrow and colourful "Ruas" that hide authentic "tabernas" where the Fado brings us far away in the past. Day 3. LISBON

Breakfast then transfer from the hotel to Lisbon train station. Train Ticket in Economy. Arrival to Porto train station and transfer to hotel. Free day. Hotel accommodation.

Day 4. PORTO

Breakfast then join a morning Panoramic Sightseeing Tour in **Oporto**, a **World Heritage city**. The **Porto cathedral**, Stock Exchange Building, Santa Clara Church are some of the monuments you will admire, as well as one of the most famous cellars in the city. Hotel accommodation.

Breakfast then transfer to Porto airport or train station.

LISBON My To-Do List.

- 1) Hop-On-Hop-Off Sightseeing Bus Tour to get to know Lisboa.
- 2) Discover Belem Tower, and Jerónimos Monastery UNESCO world Heritage Sites.
- 3) Lisbon Cathedral or Se de Lisboa.
- 4) Do NOT miss out the Augustus Arch and Praca Do Comercio.
- 5) Walking Tour in Lisbon's colorful streets.
- 6) Walk-through Eduardo VII Park, which is the city's largest greenspace. Lisbon's Botanical Garden (Estufa Fria) is housed in this park and definitely worth exploring.
- 7) Pause at the Praça do Marquês de Pombal (Marquis of Pombal Square), which is the heart of "modern Lisbon".
- 8) Step into "Palacio dos Marqueses de Fronteira's" world.
- 9) Take Lisbon's famed Vintage Yellow Tram.
- 10) Envision Vasco Da Gama Bridge.
- 11) Tuk Tuk Ride throughout the Rossio Square and discover Lisbon's hidden gems, up-close-and-personal.
- 12) Wonder around Praça do Rossio, Lisbon's liveliest area, packed with locals and tourists alike, whose surroundings overflow with bars and restaurants.
- 13) In Rossio Square, contemplate: (1) Column of Pedro IV (2) Don Maria II National Theatre (3) Rossio Railway Station.
- 14) Take a bow in front of the statue of Rei Cristo.
- 15) Tagus River Sunset Cruise.
- 16) Sail along the Tagus River to the Atlantic Ocean; you may get a chance to see Dolphins in their natural habitat.

PORTO My To-Do List.

- 1. Porto Cathedral is a MUST-see site. Its precinct offers the view of the river, the cascading houses and the opposite bank.
- 2. Marvel at the architecture of Santa Clara Church (Igreja de Santa Clara).
- 3. From there, descend through the medieval streets to Ribeira, with its café terraces and picturesque corners. Blend in, loose your senses and take in the river with the Dom Luís Bridge and the opposite bank, before going on a cruise under Porto's Six Bridges.
- 4. Casa da Música imposing architecture is on Rotunda da Boavista, an area for Shopaholics.
- 5. Wander around Avenida dos Aliados. In between visit the Crystal Palace Gardens and Soares dos Reis Museum.
- 6. Cordoaria is another garden filled with sculptures, surrounded by churches and other monuments.
- 7. Climb the Clérigos Tower for yet another stunning view of Porto.
- 8. Walk towards Aliados, pass through its shops and art nouveau buildings. Then, from this broad avenue, stroll along the pedestrians-only Rua de Santa Catarina for more shopping.
- 9. Take a delectable pause at Café Majestic.
- 10. On the south bank of the river, go to a Port Wine lodge and taste the finest port in this unique setting.
- 11. From Ribeira, cross the Dom Luís Foot Bridge to contemplate the stunning views of Porto or take the chairlift.
- 12. Tuk Tuk ride is a must-do.
- 13. Step into the Palacio Da Bolsa (Stock Exchange Building)
- 14. Cruise on the Douro River or take the Vintage Yellow Boat.
