PROPOSED ITINERARY (Illustration)

Day 1: FRANKFURT - WÜRZBURG - ROTHENBURG OB DER TAUBER - (D)



- Depart from Frankfurt in the morning for a picturesque drive through the Spessart mountains to Würzburg, on the banks of the river Main. Enjoy a guided tour of the magnificent Residence, a masterpiece of baroque architecture and UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- On the world famous *Romantic Road* we move on to Rothenburg ob der Tauber, Germany's well preserved 'Jewel of the Middle Ages'. During a city walk, including a visit of St. Jacob's Church and its Holy Blood Altar by Tilman Riemenschneider. Succumb to the unique charm of this town. Leisure time.
- In the evening our welcome dinner with complimentary drink will be served at the hotel. Afterwards, join an unforgettable tour with the Night Watchman. Overnight at Hotel Eisenhut or similar.

Day 2: ROTHENBURG - AUGSBURG - MUNICH - (B)



- Continue our journey along the Romantic Road. On the way to **Augsburg**, admire the charming villages of *Dinkelsbuehl* or *Noerdlingen*. Head towards the Bavarian capital, **Munich**. The orientation tour will take you through **Nymphenburg Castle** and the **Olympic Grounds**. Check-in at our hotel.
- In the afternoon, enjoy a walking tour till 17:00, passing by 'Glockenspiel' (carillon) at **Marienplatz**.
- In the evening, free time at leisure.
- Would you like to have a look at the 'Hofbraeuhaus'; or attend a concert or an opera? Please just ask your guide! Overnight at *Hotel Rivoli* or similar.

Day 3: MUNICH - GARMISCH - PARTENKIRCHEN - ETTAL -- FUESSEN - (B)



- If and only if weather conditions on this day are favorable, drive to **Garmisch-Partenkirchen**, situated at the foot of our highest mountain '**Zugspitze**' - one of the most important winter sport towns in Southern Germany -. Head towards the **Benedictine abbey of Ettal** and to **Oberammergau**, a village famous internationally for its **Passion Play** (generally performed every ten years) and for its numerous buildings with tromp l'oeil (**Lueftlmalerei**) painted façades.
- Continue to **Fuessen**, pause at the glorious rococo church in **Wies**, where we can admire during sunny days, the stunning Bavarian Alps. Overnight at *Luitpoldpark-Hotel* or similar.

Day 4: FUESSEN - HOHENSCHWANGAU - LINDERHOF - ROTTENBUCH - FUESSEN - (B)



- From **Fuessen**, take a short trip to **Hohenschwangau** and visit **Neuschwanstein**, the breathtaking fairytale castle of **King Ludwig II** perched on the rugged hill.
- Continue to **Linderhof** on a scenic Alps tour through Austria. Linderhof is the only palace whom ‘Mad King Ludwig’ lived to see completed. Late afternoon, we return to **Fuessen**, end the tour at the **monastery church Rottenbuch**. Overnight at **Luitpoldpark-Hotel** or similar.

Day 5: FUESSEN - LINDAU - LAKE CONSTANCE - (B)



Breakfast, check-out then head to **Lake Constance** (on the north shore) located between Germany, Switzerland and Austria. Enjoy a walking tour of the beautiful village **Lindau** then proceed to **Konstanz**. Lake Constance’s main historical town is located at Germany’s border with Switzerland and is also the birthplace of **Count Ferdinand von Zeppelin**, the famous airship pioneer. Check-in at our hotel in the nearby city **Singen**. Overnight at **Holiday Inn Express** or similar.

Day 6: LAKE CONSTANCE - BLACK FOREST - FREIBURG - HEIDELBERG - (B/D)



- Journey to the **Black Forest**, a region known for its *delicious cake*, *wooden cuckoo clocks* and spectacular landscapes. Visit a clockmaker and taste a typical cake. Enjoy a drive through the beautiful countryside towards the idyllic town of **Freiburg**. After a city tour we continue to **Heidelberg**, the oldest *German university town* where you will see the inner courtyard of the impressive castle, *UNESCO World Heritage Site*, *wine cellar* and the big barrels.
- In the evening, we will end our German Romantic Journey with a farewell dinner at the famous Restaurant *Zum Ritter St. Georg*, built in the 16th century. Overnight at *Hotel Zum Ritter St. Georg* or similar.

Day 7: HEIDELBERG - RUESDESHEIM - FRANKFURT - (B)



- Leave Heidelberg in the early morning for the **Upper Middle Rhine Valley**, *UNESCO World Heritage Site*, famous for its wines and vineyards. In **Ruedesheim** we board a *steamer* for a *Rhine river cruise*, passing fascinating castles, ruins and the legendary *Loreley Rock*. Maybe, from the deck of the ship, you will see the *blond maid* combing her hair.
- Return from **St. Goarshausen** by coach to **Frankfurt**. The journey ends with a small panoramic city tour of Frankfurt, Germany's financial capital at around 16:00.
