The country is famous for its mosques, palaces, riads, and medinas, each featuring intricate designs and captivating artistry. Some examples of iconic architectural landmarks in Morocco include the Hassan II Mosque in Casablanca, Bahia Palace in Marrakech, and the ancient Roman ruins of Volubilis.

Erfoud, Jewish Morocco, is a desert area that was underwater hundred of thousands of years ago. Erfoud is built on fossils which sustain an important industry. Try the wood-fired madfouna or Berber 'pizza' and Erfoud dates.

Casablanca's waterfront boulevard (Corniche) is lined with umbrella-shaded beach cafés, chic lounges, and ocean-view restaurants. Casablanca's port is one of the largest artificial ports in the world, and the second largest port in North Africa.

Rabat is a cultural city deep-rooted in history. Many masterpieces decorate its streets and squares. Visit the Kasbah des Oudayas which is a majestic and splendid architecture embellished by the surrounding gardens.

ITINERARY

1st Day (Sun.) MARRAKECH

Meet and assistance at the airport, transfer to the hotel. Balance of the day at leisure. Accommodation and dinner at the hotel. (D)

2nd Day (Mon.) MARRAKECH



Departure today to visit the city called "Pearl of the South". Visit that begins in the magnificent Menara Gardens, which has a side pavilion and an infinity of olive trees. After, visit outside the minaret of the Koutoubia, twin tower of the Giralda of Seville. Once inside the old part of the city, a visit to the Bahia Palace, property of a nobleman of the city, takes place. We finally go to the Jemaa el Fna square, one of the most interesting places in Morocco, from where they access the souks and the medina. Guilds of artisans of wood, ceramics, furriers etc. they will be the places they visit. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (BD)

3rd Day (Tue.) MARRAKECH - CASABLANCA - RABAT - MEKNES - FEZ



Breakfast. Early departure to Casablanca. Upon arrival, join a panoramic view of Casablanca, including the Mohamed V square, United Nations Square, Notre-Dame Lourdes Cathedral, Corniche or the seafront and the exteriors of the famous Hassan II mosque. We continue to Rabat and visit the city including the exterior of the Royal Palace, Hassan Tower, Mohamed V Mausoleum and the ruins of the Oudaya. We continue towards Meknes, imperial city. Brief stop and continue to Fez. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (BD)

4th Day (Wed.) FEZ



Breakfast at the hotel and visit Fez, considered the religious capital of the country. Founded in the 8th century by Idriss II, it is considered one of the four imperial capitals. See the exteriors of the Royal Palace, Jewish quarter and the fort that has the best view of Fez el Bali, and a visit to the Medina or old city where we will do a walking tour accessing the famous gate of Bab el Jeloud and having the possibility of living a return to the past in a part of the city that still lives near the middle ages. Walls that protect its interior formed by hundreds of streets “labyrinths” organized where customers can live a thousand scents and flavors in this place considered a world heritage site. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (BD)

5th Day (Thu.) FEZ - MIDELT - ERFOUD



Breakfast at the hotel and departure towards the Middle Atlas, towards Ifrane, a small mountainous town known for its ski resort. Brief panoramic stop to enjoy the landscape and continue to Midelt, capital of the Middle Atlas. In the afternoon, route towards Er-Rachidia enjoying semi desert landscapes and the first large palm groves, until you reach Erfoud, capital of the Tafilalet region and cradle of the Alauita dynasty, reigning in Morocco today. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (BD)

OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS*:

- Sunrise in the dunes of Erg Chebbi - Excursion in a 4x4 vehicle to see the sunrise in the desert. Departure very early in the morning of the 5th day of the tour from our hotel in Erfoud to the sea of dunes of Erg Chebbi, where you can see the sun's effect at dawn and take a dromedary ride. Return to the hotel for breakfast.
- Night in the dunes of Erg Chebbi - Upon arrival in Erfoud, continue towards Merzouga where the 4x4 vehicle awaits to take you to the camp. During the journey you will be able to enjoy the magic of this landscape. Berber dinner and accommodation in the camp. The camp has camels that clients can ride in the early morning and enjoy the sunrise in the dunes. For this service you must notify at the arrival to the camp, where they will inform you about all the details of this included activity. (If you hire this optional excursion, you cannot make use of the Erfoud hotel and there is no refund for not using the hotel in Erfoud.)

6th Day (Fri.) ERFOUD - TINERHIR - OUARZAZATE



Breakfast. Departure to Tinerhir to visit this great oasis and its spectacular natural gorges of Todra. Continue to Ouarzazate, where we will stay. Dinner and accommodation. (BD)

7th Day (Sat.) OUARZAZATE - MARRAKECH



Breakfast at the hotel and departure to the Kasbah of Taourirt, in the past owned by Pacha Glaoui. Continuation of the route to the fortified city of Ait Benhaddou for the visit of its famous Kasbah, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Departure towards Marrakech crossing the pass Tizi'n Tichka mountain pass located at 2,260meter altitude. Arrival in Marrakech, dinner and accommodation. (BD)

8th Day (Sun.) MARRAKECH

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer from hotel to the airport. (B) End of our service.
