Granada is music and poetry, monuments which are pure art, and ancient culture. Granada's craggy summits of the Sierra Nevada mountains, breathtaking architecture, white villages scattered across hills and valleys ...is a great historic and cultural value - a tourist destination par excellence.

Toledo is truly one of Spain's most magnificent cities. Dramatically sited atop a gorge overlooking the Rio Tajo, it was known as the 'city of three cultures'- Christian, Muslim and Jewish communities peacefully coexisted. ..Horseshoe-arched mosques, Sephardic synagogues and one of Spain's finest Gothic cathedrals cram into its dense historical core.

## ITINERARY

### 1° Day (Sat.) MADRID

Meet & greet at the airport and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Accommodation at the hotel.

### 2° Day (Sun.) MADRID



Breakfast at the hotel. Discover the beauties of the city in a panoramic tour. Find the medieval origins of the city, like the **Arabic fortress**, at the **Barrio de la Morería**, famous for its historical buildings. Drive through the **Hapsburgs District**, **Puerta del Sol**, **Plaza Mayor** and **Plaza de la Villa**; the **Madrid of the Bourbons** and the complex town planning schemes of Charles III, the **Royal Palace**, **Cibeles** and **Neptuno Fountains** and the **Puerta de Alcalá**. The contemporary Madrid with areas such as Gran Vía, Castellana, the district of Salamanca, Plaza Castilla and Parque del Oeste, as well as commercial and financial areas of Modern Madrid, the emblematic Las Ventas Bullring and the Santiago Bernabéu Football Stadium. Afternoon at leisure to continue exploring the wonders that the city has to offer. Accommodation at the hotel. (B)

### 3rd Day (Mon.) MADRID - CORDOBA - SEVILLA



Drive along La Mancha, Don Quixote's land, passing by a typical site in Puerto Lapice. Cross through the natural border of "Despeñaperros" and get into Andalusia, a region for itself that shows an enormous heritage from a splendid past. Reach Cordoba. Impressive tour of its Mosque and other sites that will ease our mind and spirit strolling through its narrow winding streets of the Jewish Quarter. In the afternoon, after a short two hours ride reach Seville. Accommodation at the hotel. (B)

**4<sup>th</sup> Day (Tue.) SEVILLE**



Breakfast at the hotel. Morning panoramic city tour visiting the Cathedral (the second largest in the Catholic world after St. Peter's in Rome), Santa Cruz quarter (a natural scenario of "Carmen" as well as a precisely where the myth of "Don Juan" developed), Maria Luisa Park and Plaza de España. Afternoon at leisure for you to discover exclusive views, specific flavors of this active full of light city. Accommodation at the hotel. Optional Flamenco show. (B)

**5<sup>th</sup> Day (Wed.) SEVILLE - GRANADA**



After breakfast at the hotel drive east through the Caliphate road to the heart of Andalusia observing an endless number of olive trees on the way to Granada and its incredible and amazing monumental environment, last stronghold of the Moorish Kingdoms up to 1492. Visit the world famous Alhambra complex and Generalife Gardens that have inspired several authors with its sound and sights, such as the "Tales of the Alhambra" by W. Irving. At night, optionally, Zambra Flamenca show in the Sacromonte neighborhood. Accommodation at the hotel. (B)

**6<sup>th</sup> Day (Thu.) GRANADA**



Breakfast at the hotel and free day to enjoy the Nazari capital. Granada is more than the Alhambra; the Muslim heritage runs through every corner of the city and mixes with the Christian tradition, giving rise to a unique city. Overnight at the hotel. (B)

7<sup>th</sup> Day (Fri.) GRANADA - TOLEDO - MADRID



Breakfast at the hotel. Drive northward where it emerges, toward the sky of Castilla and surrounded by the Tagus River, the impressive Imperial city of Toledo -World Heritage City- where the three cultures Christians, Moorish and Jewish, have lived together. Resume of the Spanish art, history and spirituality, the whole town is a National Monument. Short guided tour of this historical old town through its narrow streets. Continue to Madrid. Accommodation at the hotel (B)

8<sup>th</sup> Day (Sat.) MADRID

Breakfast at the hotel, then transfer to the airport. (B)
