ITINERARY

DAY 1: PRAGUE



- Welcome to Prague! Upon arriving at the airport, transfer to hotel. Check the information boards in the hotel reception area for details about the welcome meeting with your guide.
- In the evening, transfer to the **Old Town Square**, a lively area bustling with tourist activity. You can enjoy dinner at one of the many restaurants. Afterward, return transfer to hotel.

DAY 2: PRAGUE

- Today, we'll visit the capital, Prague, the Baroque jewel of Europe. Our local tour guide will lead an informative **panoramic tour**, highlighting the city's most outstanding monuments. Visit **Prague Castle** (admission included).
- Boat ride on the Vltava River (included). In the afternoon, free time to explore the city on your own.

DAY 3: PRAGUE, PILSEN, ROTHENBURG, FRANKFURT



- Depart early from Prague and stop in **PILSEN**, in western Bohemia, a city renowned for its beer.
- Wonder around its historic center: **Old Town Square**, **Cathedral**, **Plague Column**, and a Renaissance-era town hall.
- Cross into Germany and follow *part* of the *Romantic Road*. We'll visit **ROTHENBURG**, a town that seems to come straight out of a fairy tale, and is considered one of the most beautiful villages in the country.
- Head to **FRANKFURT**, the financial capital of Germany. Upon arrival in the evening, enjoy free time in the historic city center, where you'll find a wide variety of restaurants.

DAY 4: FRANKFURT, CRUISE ON THE RHINE, COLOGNE, AMSTERDAM



- Today, we'll take a scenic **CRUISE ON THE RHINE** between the villages of **Rüdesheim** and **St. Goar**, the river's most picturesque section.
- Journey to **COLOGNE**, known for its immense Gothic cathedral.
- Then, head to Holland, arriving in **Amsterdam** in the evening.

DAY 5: AMSTERDAM

- Admire some picturesque spots in Holland. Visit **ZAANSE SCHANS**, known for its windmills, canals, and houses.
- Explore **Volendam**, a picturesque fishing village. A short boat trip from **VOLENDAM** will take us to **MARKEN**, an island connected to the mainland by a dike, where the houses are built on stilts.
- Then, head to **AMSTERDAM** for a panoramic tour of the city, including its narrow canals, official buildings, and parks. We'll also see a diamond-cutting demonstration.
- At the end of the day, we'll provide a transfer to the lively city center, the bustling area with many restaurants.

DAY 6: AMSTERDAM, BRUGES, PARIS



- Journey to **BRUGES**, a charming medieval city often called the "Venice of the North" due to its scenic canals. The city offers a magical atmosphere with its cobblestone streets, historic buildings, and romantic bridges.
- How about: climbing the **Belfry Tower** for stunning views? Or trying some Belgian chocolate? Or have a local craft beer?
- We will then continue our journey to Paris, arriving by the end of the day.

DAY 7: PARIS

- Immerse in the rich history of France at the magnificent **Versailles Palace** (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens.
- On our return to Paris, we'll visit **Montmartre**, where a cable car (included) will take us up to this charming bohemian neighborhood, famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets.
- To fully appreciate the grandeur of **Paris**, we'll embark on a panoramic city tour with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel.
- Optional: variety shows in the evening.



DAY 8: PARIS



- Visit the iconic **Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the second floor of this famous iron landmark (tickets included).
- Take a relaxing boat cruise along the Seine, which will last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes (1H 15Min). You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace.
- Note: If the waiting time at the Eiffel Tower is too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.
- Our journey will come to an end, leaving you with wonderful and lasting memories.
- Please, check the time of your flight in case you might need an additional night.
