DAY 1, SUNDAY: ATHENS

- Welcome and transfer to hotel, free time.
- In the afternoon, find information about the tour on the boards located at the hotel reception.

Day 2, MONDAY: ATHENS



- Embark on a city tour of Athens with a local guide, visiting the landmarks: Presidential Mansion, Panathenaic Stadium where the first modern Olympic Games were held, National Library, and bustling squares of the city center.
- Explore the newer neighborhoods that developed after the 2004 Olympic Games. The tour will conclude at the Acropolis (admission not included).
- In the evening, we'll provide a transfer to the historical neighborhood of Plaka, renowned for its charming Greek tavernas and opportunities to immerse yourself in the rich folklore of this country.

Day 3, TUESDAY: ATHENS - KAMENA VOURLA - KALABAKA

Total distance covered: 410 km

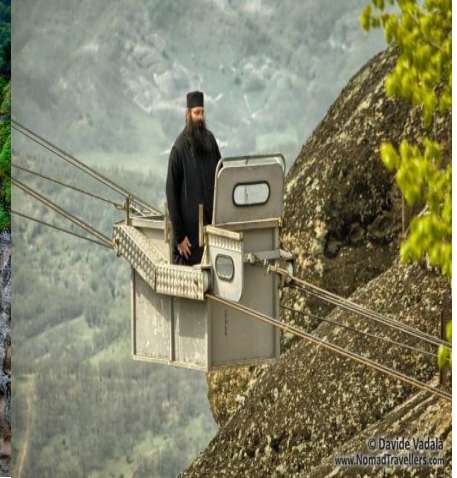


- Depart early morning towards northern Greece, stopping at Kamena Vourla, a charming seaside tourist hub surrounded by stunning landscapes.
- Proceed north, stopping at the Thermopylae Mountain Pass, the historic site of the famous battle.
- Visit Kastraki, a picturesque village with beautiful views of the entire valley, where you'll have free time for lunch.
- Explore the Meteora, a breathtaking UNESCO World Heritage Site. Admission to one of its renowned monasteries is included.
- Dinner will be provided in Kalabaka.

Tour's Details & Schedule:

- 🕒 08:00 a.m.: Departure from Athens, head north and travel through pleasant Mediterranean landscapes.
- 🕒 10:15 a.m.: Kamena Vourla, a charming seaside tourist center with magnificent scenery. Time for a stroll & coffee.
- 🕒 11:15 a.m.: Departure from Kamena Vourla, drive through the Greek hinterland, brief stop at the mountain pass where the Battle of Thermopylae took place.
- 🕒 01:45 p.m.: Kastraki. Stop in this picturesque town at the foot of the Meteora. Optional lunch. Visit the Meteora, an impressive UNESCO World Heritage site with monasteries that seem to "hang" from the rocks. We'll stop to visit one of the monasteries (admission included) and see the remaining ones perched atop immense rock formations.
- 🕒 Accommodation will be in Kalabaka, a small town in the center of the Meteora region.
- 🕒 Dinner will be included.

Note: Wear appropriate clothing (women will be provided skirts upon arrival at the monastery). Comfortable footwear as you will need to climb many steps!

DAY 4, WEDNESDAY: KALABAKA - DELPHI - ATHENS

Total distance covered: 435 km



- Journey south through the Thessaly region, admire stunning landscapes, before reaching Delphi.
- Explore the exquisite archaeological site in Delphi overlooking the Gulf of Corinth, with breathtaking views.
- Time for lunch at leisure.
- Head to the Hosios Loukas Monastery, renowned as one of the most beautiful Byzantine monasteries in Greece and a World Heritage Site. Its magnificent 11th century mosaics are truly remarkable.
- Continue to arrive in Athens in the evening. End of our services.

Tour's Details & Schedule:

Note: The order of the day's program may vary; we may visit the Hosios Loukas Monastery before Delphi.

- 🕒 08:00 a.m.: Departure from Kalabaka, drive through Thessaly towards Central Greece, enjoying spectacular sea views, before reaching Delphi.
- 🕒 11:30 a.m.: Delphi. Admission included to the beautiful archaeological complex overlooking the Gulf of Corinth, a magical place. There will be time for lunch.
- 🕒 02:30 p.m.: Departure from Delphi. We'll continue our journey amidst mountains with Mount Parnassus dominating the landscape.
- 🕒 03:15 p.m.: Hosios Loukas Monastery. Arrival at one of the most beautiful Byzantine monasteries in Greece, a World Heritage Site, with breathtaking 11th century mosaics.
- 🕒 04:30 p.m.: Departure from Hosios Loukas.
- 🕒 07:15 p.m.: Athens.
