ITINERARY

DAY 1, TUESDAY: SEVILLA

Transfer to hotel and some free time.

In the afternoon, you'll find information about the start of your tour on the boards located at the hotel reception.

DAY 2, WEDNESDAY: SEVILLA



- In the morning, we'll embark on a city tour of Seville:
- Sevilla Cathedral with its famous Giralda,
- Banks of the Guadalquivir River,
- Popular neighborhoods of Santa Cruz and Triana.
- After the tour, enjoy a relaxing boat ride on the Guadalquivir River offering stunning panoramic views (included).
- In the evening, you'll have the option to attend a popular flamenco tablao.

Tour Details: A local guide will enrich our experience with insights into the history and culture of Andalusia's capital, starting our journey around nine in the morning. Highlights include the Cathedral and Giralda, Santa Cruz neighborhood, the Guadalquivir riverbanks, Torre del Oro, Maestranza Bullring, Cartuja Island (former Expo site and home to Isla Mágica amusement park), and María Luisa Park with its stunning Plaza de España. After the tour, enjoy a relaxing boat ride on the Guadalquivir River offering stunning panoramic views (included). The tour, lasting approximately 3 hours including the boat ride, will conclude with free time in the afternoon. Optionally, the guide will offer the opportunity for those interested to visit the cathedral and attend a flamenco performance at a tablao in the evening.

DAY 3, THURSDAY: SEVILLE - CARMONA - CÓRDOBA

Total distance covered: 153 km

- Breakfast then journey to Carmona, a city with over 3,000 years of history, renowned for its Mudejar and Renaissance-style old town.
- After a leisurely stroll, we'll continue to Almodóvar del Río to visit its imposing Moorish castle (tickets and cab ride up to the site are included), offering spectacular views.
- Head to Córdoba. Free time for lunch and to explore its historic center, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Visit the Mosque-Cathedral with a local guide (tickets included), followed by a walk through the old quarter and its famous patios filled with flowers.
- Admission to the Old Synagogue will also be included.
- Just outside Córdoba, we'll visit Medina Azahara * (tickets included), the majestic city-palace of the Umayyad Caliphate.

*Note *: From June 21 to September 20, the visit to Medina Azahara will take place in the evening to avoid the heat and enjoy the cooler temperatures and lighting of the site at night. Recommend comfortable shoes.*

Tour's Details & Schedule:

- ⌚ 08:30 a.m.: After breakfast, we'll leave the Andalusian capital behind.
- ⌚ 09:00 a.m.: Carmona. We'll stop for a walk in this historic Andalusian city, known for its rich cultural and monumental heritage. Founded over 3,000 years ago, it has been home to several civilizations, including Phoenicians, Romans, and Arabs. The old town, with its cobblestone streets, charming squares, and Mudejar and Renaissance-style buildings, offers an authentic glimpse into the past.
- ⌚ 10:00 a.m.: Departure from Carmona.
- ⌚ 11:15 a.m.: Almodóvar del Río. We'll visit the impressive Moorish castle, with admission and cab ride up to the site included. You'll get to see its walls, towers, and courtyards, and enjoy breathtaking views. The castle is also famous as a filming location for the series Game of Thrones.
- ⌚ 12:15 p.m.: Departure from Almodóvar del Río.
- ⌚ 12:45 p.m.: Córdoba. Arrival in this renowned city, once the capital of the Caliphate of Córdoba during the Islamic era. You'll have free time to explore the city center. After lunch, we'll include a city tour with a local guide and tickets to the magnificent Mosque-Cathedral, the city's most iconic monument and a masterpiece of both Islamic and Christian architecture. During the tour, you'll see the old quarter, a World Heritage Site full of narrow streets, flower-filled patios and historical buildings, and the Old Synagogue (admission included).
- ⌚ 04:30 p.m.: Departure from Córdoba after the panoramic tour.
- ⌚ 04:50 p.m.: Medina Azahara (admission included). Just outside Córdoba, we'll visit the archaeological site of Medina Azahara, a city-palace built in the 10th century by the Umayyad Caliph Abd al-Rahman III. Designed as a symbol of the caliphate's power and splendor, this World Heritage Site offers a glimpse into Andalusia's past.
- ⌚ 06:00 p.m.: Departure from Medina Azahara, returning to Córdoba.
- ⌚ 06:20 p.m.: Córdoba. You'll have time to continue exploring and enjoying the city.

DAY 4, FRIDAY: CÓRDOBA - BAENA - GRANADA

Total distance covered: 168 km

- Breakfast then drive through vast olive groves to Baena, a town with Roman roots, renowned for its high-quality olive oil production.
- Visit the Núñez de Prado Olive Oil Mill, one of the oldest in the Mediterranean, housed in an 18th century building. Here, we'll learn about olive oil production and enjoy a tasting of pan con aceite (bread with olive oil).
- Continue to Granada, famous for the Alhambra (admission and guided tour included), a masterpiece of Islamic architecture and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Lunch will be included. Free time in the afternoon to visit the cathedral or take a stroll through the Albaicín neighborhood, where you'll find spectacular views of the Alhambra.

Tour's Details & Schedule:

- 🕒 09:00 a.m.: Departure from Córdoba after breakfast, crossing through vast regions of olive groves.
- 🕒 10:00 a.m.: Baena. We'll stop in this charming town with Roman roots, renowned for producing high-quality olive oil. We'll visit the Núñez de Prado Olive Oil Mill, one of the oldest in the Mediterranean, housed in an 18th-century building, where traditional methods have been passed down through generations. Here, we'll learn about olive oil production and olive groves, and enjoy a tasting of pan con aceite (bread with olive oil).
- 🕒 11:15 a.m.: Departure from Baena.
- 🕒 12:45 p.m.: Granada. Arrival in one of Spain's most iconic cities. It's most famous monument, the Alhambra, is a magnificent Nasrid palace and citadel and UNESCO World Heritage Site, stands as one of the finest examples of Islamic architecture in Europe. Admission and guided visit to the Alhambra are included. Lunch is also included. Afterward, you'll have free time to explore the city at your own pace, during which you can visit the cathedral or stroll through the Albaicín, the old Moorish quarter with narrow-cobbled streets that offers stunning views of the Alhambra.

DAY 5, SATURDAY: GRANADA - NERJA - FRIGILIANA - MALAGA

Total distance covered: 158 km



- Contemplate the stunning landscape of Sierra Nevada mountain range.
- Journey along the Mediterranean, the Costa Tropical, where a year-round mild microclimate allows the cultivation of tropical fruits and crops e.g. guavas, mango, avocado, sugar cane.
- Stop in Nerja, a charming coastal village with impressive cliffs.
- Head to Frigiliana, considered one of the most beautiful villages in Andalusia, with its steep streets lined with whitewashed houses.
- Continue to Malaga, capital of the Costa del Sol, known for its many museums, as the birthplace of Picasso, and the unfinished cathedral La Manquita, meaning in English “The One-Armed Lady”.
- Free time for lunch and to explore the city center, or if the weather allows it, you can enjoy a visit to the beach for a swim.

Tour's Details & Schedule:

- ⌚ 08:30 a.m.: Departure from Granada. We'll enjoy spectacular scenery as we cross the Sierra Nevada mountain range on an impressive highway. We'll then continue our journey along the Mediterranean, on the so-called Costa Tropical, where the mild microclimate throughout the year allows the cultivation of tropical fruits and crops such as guavas, mango, and avocado, and in the past, sugar cane.
- ⌚ 10:00 a.m.: Nerja. We'll have time for a walk in this charming village on the Costa del Sol. From the viewpoint, the so-called Balcón de Nerja, in the center of town, you'll enjoy a panoramic view of the sea, the coast, and its cliffs, and on many occasions, even Africa.
- ⌚ 11:15 a.m.: Departure from Nerja.
- ⌚ 11:30 a.m.: Frigiliana. Time to discover the charming corners of this village, considered one of the most beautiful in Andalusia, with its steep streets surrounded by impeccably whitewashed houses.
- ⌚ 12:45 p.m.: Departure from Frigiliana.
- ⌚ 01:45 p.m.: Malaga. Arrival in the capital of Costa del Sol, known as the city of museums, the birthplace of Picasso, and famous for the unfinished cathedral La Manquita, meaning in English “The One-Armed Lady”. You'll have time for lunch and to explore the city center, or if the weather allows it, you can enjoy a visit to the beach for a swim.

DAY 6, SUNDAY: MALAGA - PUERTO BANÚS - RONDA - SETENIL DE LAS BODEGAS - OLVERA - JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA

Total distance covered: 255 km



- Immerse in one of the most beautiful stages of the trip, travelling through the Andalusian White Towns and mountain ranges. Leave early in the morning for Puerto Banús in Marbella, one of the most luxurious marinas in Spain, famous for its yachts and high-fashion boutiques.
- Stroll around, then continue to Ronda, a picturesque town perched on the Tajo gorge.
- Time to explore, and enjoy a traditional lunch before visiting the bullring (included), one of the oldest and most spectacular in Spain (admission included).



- Head to Setenil de las Bodegas, a marvelous white village with houses built into the rock.
- Continue to Olvera, known for its Moorish castle, neoclassical church, and balconies filled with flowers, a classic Andalusian scene. Visit the castle and museum (admission included).
- Arrive in Jerez de la Frontera in the evening, where we recommend a stroll through the historic center and enjoying tapas in the tabancos.

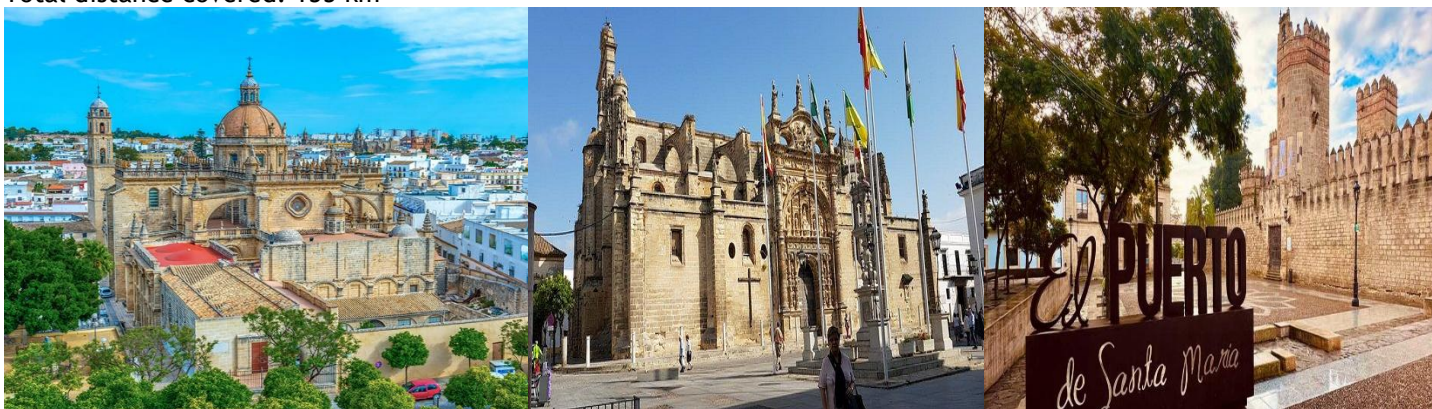
Tour's Details & Schedule:

- ⌚ 08:30 a.m.: Departure from Málaga, following the Mediterranean coast.
- ⌚ 09:30 a.m.: Puerto Banús (Marbella). We'll have time to stroll around one of Spain's most exclusive and luxurious marinas, a popular destination for celebrities. Its docks are lined with luxury yachts, and the surrounding area features high-end designer boutiques.
- ⌚ 10:45 a.m.: Departure from Puerto Banús. We'll continue our journey through beautiful scenery toward the Andalusian mountains.
- ⌚ 12:00 p.m.: Ronda. We'll arrive in one of the most picturesque cities in Andalusia, perched on a deep gorge known as El Tajo, which splits the city in two. You'll have time to explore, enjoy a traditional included lunch, and visit the bullring (admission included), famous for being one of the oldest and most spectacular in Spain, inaugurated in 1785.
- ⌚ 03:00 p.m.: Departure from Ronda.

- ⌚ 03:30 p.m.: Setenil de las Bodegas. We'll have time for a walk and a coffee in this spectacular white village embedded in the rock, known for its cave houses.
- ⌚ 05:00 p.m.: Departure from Setenil de las Bodegas.
- ⌚ 05:30 p.m.: Olvera. We'll stop in this picturesque village in the Sierra de Cádiz. Highlights include its 12th-century Moorish castle and neoclassical church. The cobblestone streets and whitewashed houses with balconies filled with flowers are a classic Andalusian scene. Admission to the castle and museum is included, offering insights into the history and lifestyle of Andalusian villages in the early 20th century.
- ⌚ 07:00 p.m.: Departure from Olvera.
- ⌚ 08:30 p.m.: Jerez de la Frontera. We recommend a stroll through the historic center, a visit to the cathedral, and enjoying tapas in the traditional tabancos.

DAY 7, MONDAY: JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA - EL PUERTO DE SANTA MARÍA - CÁDIZ - SEVILLE

Total distance covered: 155 km



- Located in the heart of Andalusia, Jerez is famous for its wine tradition, equestrian culture, and flamenco.
- Breakfast then photograph the exterior of the Moorish Alcázar, and visit the Andalusian Flamenco Center, a symbol of Jerez's cultural identity.
- Visit the Royal Andalusian School of Equestrian Art (admission included) to see the harness museum and watch the training of Andalusian horses.
- Continue to Puerto de Santa María, a town renowned for its wines and seafood, where we'll visit the Bodegas Osborne for a wine tasting (admission and tasting included).
- Free time, then take a boat to Cádiz for a half-hour crossing. Free time to explore this ancient city, one of the oldest in Europe, known for its cathedral and charming historic center.
- In the afternoon, take the magnificent bridge to Seville, arriving by the end of the day.

Tour's Details & Schedule:

- ⌚ 12:30 p.m.: Departure from Jerez.
- ⌚ 01:00 p.m.: Puerto de Santa María. We'll discover this seafaring city, famous for its wines and gastronomy, especially seafood and fresh fish. Admission to the Bodegas Osborne, known for their iconic bull logo, is included, with a guided tour, a walk through the Toro Gallery, and a tasting of their wines. You'll have free time to stroll around and enjoy lunch. We recommend dining at the restaurants on the Ribera del Marisco.
- ⌚ 04:00 p.m.: Departure from Puerto de Santa María. We'll take a boat for a half-hour trip to Cádiz. Enjoy the sea!
- ⌚ 04:30 p.m.: Cádiz. Free time in one of the oldest cities in Europe, founded by the Phoenicians. Its historic center, known as "La Habana Chica" due to its striking resemblance to the Cuban capital, is of great beauty, with lively squares, narrow streets, and a stunning cathedral.
- ⌚ 07:00 p.m.: Departure from Cádiz. In the late afternoon, we'll leave the city, crossing the magnificent suspension bridge towards Seville.
- ⌚ 08:30 p.m.: Seville. Arrival in the evening.

DAY 8, TUESDAY: SEVILLA

Breakfast. Hotel check-out time is usually 10:00 a.m. Transfer to airport is not included.
