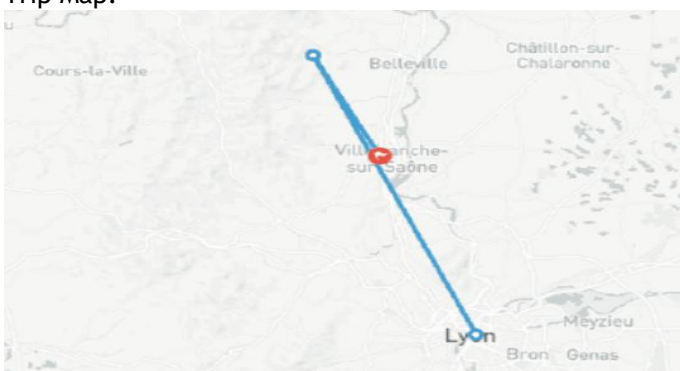





ITINERARY

DAY 1: VILLEFRANCHE-SUR-SAONE TO BEAUJOLAIS WINE REGION



- Y Bonjour, welcome to your foodie adventure!
- Y Transfer from Villefranche-sur-Saone Station to our 16th Century Chateau: accommodation complete with a bar, swimming pool and dreamy views of the surrounding vineyards.
- Y Once we've checked in and chilled out we'll be feeling like royalty, and that's before we enjoy some local wine paired with cheese.
- Y Then our team of live-in chefs will prepare an authentic French Dinner. We'll tuck in while enjoying magnificent views of the Beaujolais countryside. What a day, and we're just getting started...

DAY 2: BEAUJOLAIS WINE REGION



- Y Rise and shine! After a hearty homemade breakfast and some on-the-lawn yoga.
- Y Visit one of the local wineries that this region is famous for.
- Y Learn about the world-famous **Beaujolais Nouveau**, meet a local winemaker, sample some of their finest drops - paired with an included lunch.
- Y Stuffed with a new knowledge of wine and food, we'll head back to the chateau for a well-deserved chilled night, including a dinner too. After, free to chill out as you like... swim, walk, or just kick back on the terrace.

DAY 3: LYON



- Y Breakfast, journey to Lyon. On a foodie walking tour, we'll sample the city's prettiest and tastiest food spots, with a local guide to impart all their knowledge and wisdom.
- Y Uncover 'Hidden Lyon' through secret passageways, known locally as **Traboules**.
- Y Head to the local village, for a 3 course farewell dinner of traditional French cuisine.
- Y After dinner, explore this charming village before heading back to the château for a glass of wine at the bar.

Its center reflects 2,000 years of history from the Roman Amphithéâtre des Trois Gaules, medieval and Renaissance architecture in Vieux (Old) Lyon, to the modern Confluence district on Presqu'île peninsula, Traboules, covered passageways between buildings, connect Vieux Lyon and La Croix-Rousse hill...

The city is recognised for its cuisine and gastronomy, as well as historical and architectural landmarks; as such, the districts of Old Lyon, the Fourvière hill, the Presqu'île and the slopes of the Croix-Rousse are inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List

Enrich your stay, why Lyon is called "Food Capital of the World"?

Lyon has some 4000 restaurants (including 16 with Michelin stars in 2023). There's no shortage of reasons for Lyon's stellar reputation.

- excellence of individual products themselves have helped catapult Lyon towards fame
- one of France's most fertile regions
- the famous "mères", or mothers, were chefs who left domestic cooking to open their own restaurants. These would have a major influence on Lyon's culinary scene and set the stage for future generations of chefs.
- as does Paris with its "bouillons", Lyon has its own traditional eateries, the "bouchons", which serve as the backbone of the city's food scene with their authentic, local cuisine.
